Short Biography:

Nenad Stekić has been working at the Institute of International Politics and Economics since July 2018, and as of January 2020 within the Regional Centre "Belt and Road". His academic interests include the People's Republic of China's security strategy, regional security dynamics of Southeast Asia, and the effects of interstate armed conflicts on contemporary defence arrangements and political regimes. He worked as a teaching aide in the courses of International Relations and Political System throughout his MA studies at the University of Belgrade's Faculty of Security Studies. He was hired as an external consultant by the Varieties of Democracy Institute (University of Gothenburg), where he works as an evaluator of the quality of political regimes for the V-Dem Data project (2021-2022). Dr. Stekić currently serves as a Deputy Editor-in-Chief of The Review of International Affairs – RIA scientific journal. He is fluent in English and is actively learning Chinese language.
